Alan Leo Plestina was born in 1969 in Chelmsford, Great Britain. After finishing High school of Mathematics, he continues his education at the University Of Zagreb Faculty Of Architecture and finishes it in 1997.

After gaining experience in couple of architecture and building companies, in year 2000 he becomes a business partner of Berislav Medic and Danijel Malcic in design company UPI-2M, where they hit the ground for the architectural department.

Besides architecture, he has a great affection in painting and sculpturing – therefore had several independent and group exhibitions.

As an architect he worked on numerous projects as author, co-author, leader of the architectural team, participated in domestic and international architectural or town planning competitions; been invited as member of the jury on architectural competitions, workshops, came as lecturer on various expert events and congresses.

Today he is one of three partners in UPI-2M and also engaged as an editor in specialist newspapers for architects, construction, design, photography and art called “Projekt”.

In year 2008, together with other two partners, launches the concept-bar KÔTA for architects, designers, engineers and all “spatial-art” fans. The aim of this place is to promote, develop and advance these professions by having organised various thematic events, such as new building brands promotions, expert discussions, specialist books and magazines presentations or some workshops, all in casual and stress-free atmosphere.

He is a head of committee for international cooperation in Croatian Chamber of architects and a member of General assembly (president of Croatia delegation) in ACE (Architects’ Council of Europe) in Bruxelles.
